Dear Parents, carers, staff and children

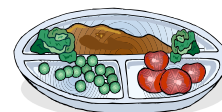
You will have received your child's school report this week. All children have had a busy and successful year. We are particularly thrilled with the progress of our year 6 children who achieved great results in their SATs.

Please note that from 2nd September dinner money will increase to £1.85 per day or £9.25 a week.



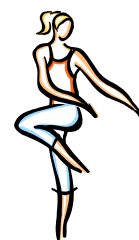
Big Toddle

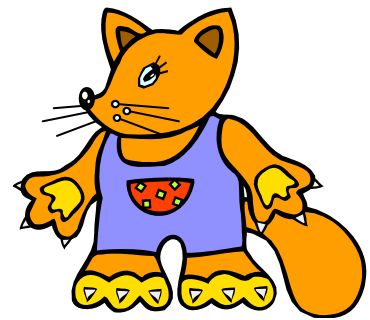
